

Philly's Pancake Breakfast Fund Raising Events

Philly's is ready willing and able to help your organization raise the much-needed funds it needs to bridge these tough economic times.

The following is an outline of the pancake breakfast event at Philly's.

The owners of Philly's will work with you and your organization to begin the process of fund raising and ticket sales.

A two week minimum window must be established in order to make your event a big success.

Once a date has been selected for the event to take place, we will begin the ticket printing process based on estimates determined by your organization. Two days are required for artwork approval and printing. The tickets will be delivered to your event administrator for distribution and sales.

This will give your organization 10 days to sell as many tickets as they possibly can.

****We can plan longer sales intervals based upon your needs.

Each ticket represents an "All you can eat" pancake breakfast for one individual.

Participation from your group members is essential and is a great way to express unity and teamwork. Your group will supply a large portion of the labor to make your event a complete success.

An average event will need:

One door greeter/ticket tender.

Two host/hostesses

Two dish washers

Two table busers

Up to four servers

These numbers are only an estimate and will vary from event to event depending on size and tickets sold.

I will personally go over all of the duties required with your group and your members will be assigned days prior to the event.

Philly's will provide the cooks and food preparation labor. Your members will not be exposed to any of our more dangerous equipment. Safety is always first!

We plan events to take place on Saturday mornings from 7:30 am to 9:30 am. All clean up must be completed by 10:00 am for us to resume operations at our normal business hours.

At the time of the event, each ticket holder redeems their ticket at the door for admission and breakfast.

Tickets are sold for \$7.00 per ticket. A tally of tickets sold must be presented to Philly's the Wednesday prior to your event so we may purchase food appropriately. Philly's receives \$2.00 from each ticket sold to cover a small portion of the food cost, labor and operational expenses.
Your group keeps \$5.00 from every ticket sold.

****Food is purchased and manpower is scheduled based upon the number of tickets sold and not the number of tickets redeemed. Therefore, an accurate count of tickets sold is required to purchase the appropriate amount of food to avoid shortages and/or waste.

Our Pancake Breakfast consists of "All you can eat" of the following items:

Plate size Buttermilk pancakes w/ whipped cinnamon honey butter and light maple syrup.

Breakfast sausage links.

Fresh Brewed Coffee with all accoutrements.

Hot Tea "honey and lemon are also made available".

Orange Juice

***Philly's staff will take care of all of the food purchasing and grill work.

Although our seating capacity is 65 people, we are very capable of feeding 200 people in the 2 hour breakfast window with ease.
